FY16-17 Industry Partnerships

The PA Department of Labor & Industry proposes funding the Industry Partnerships listed below. In total, the commonwealth would fund 28 partnerships for \$4,638,772. Partnerships would in turn train a proposed 5,551 participants in the advanced manufacturing, agriculture and food processing, building and construction, business services, energy, healthcare, and logistics and transportation industry sectors.
