The meeting was called to order by Chairman Walter Schneider.

- 1. Pledge of Allegiance
- 2. Reappointed members sworn in by Basil Merenda: Charles Coltharp, Craig Glotfelty, Kevin Maynard, Larry Mellott, and William Yeagley.
- 3. **Unanimous approval** to accept the published agenda (Motion Daniel Corbet; Second John Kampmeyer)
- 4. Chairman's Comments and Correspondence: Walter Schneider said the ICC's Pennsylvania update looks like it will be published in Aug.
- 5. Counsel's report: Thanked all members for submitting their financial disclosure documents to the Ethics Commission.
- 6. Committee reports:
  - Legislative Unanimous approval to accept the support the report presented (Motion John Kampmeyer; Second – Amrinder Singh)
    - HB 1104 adds a number of requirements to be included in permit; recommend supporting
    - HB 1526 deals with Storm Shelters; think this should be done in public buildings, so do not recommend supporting.
    - HB 1682 deals with code officials on inactive status reactivating; think language needs to be cleaned up, so do not recommend supporting.
    - HB 1790 requirements for notice of compliance during inspections, and specific reasons for decertification of officials. Requires department to provide regulation for recertification, so do not recommend supporting.
    - HB 1854 code between builder and owner not felt to be in purview of the code, so do not recommend supporting.

- HB 2079 says any refrigerant prohibited by UCC but authorized by Clean Air Act may be used. Can't see that ozone-depleting refrigerant would ever be accepted in Act, so don't recommend supporting.
- HB 2128 adds a chapter in UCC dealing with endangered species, which should be handled in project's land development phase, so don't recommend supporting.
- HB 2138 inserts chapter 8 dealing with deconstruction standards for removal of elements that can be used later. Since this is zoning, don't recommend supporting.
- HB 6354 was reported on in May of 2021 and appears to be unchanged, so don't recommend supporting.
