The subject building is not required to comply with the provisions of the Building Energy Conservation Act because:

- The buildings peak design rate of energy usage is less than one watt per square foot or 3.5 BTU/hr. per square foot of floor area for all purposes.
- The building houses equipment, machinery or processing which generates substantial heat during the normal operation of the equipment, machinery or processing. Substantial generation of heat shall mean the generation of more than 6 watts per square foot of floor area.
- The building was under design contract prior to effective date of Act 222, July 1, 1981.
- The building is considered a historic structure (letter from State Historical Preservation Officer verifying official historical status must accompany this form).
- The building is neither heated nor cooled.
- The renovation of the existing building requires less than 25% of the gross floor area or volume of the entire building to be rebuilt.
