Parts, Processes, and Procedures

Pennsylvania's workforce system policies have four main stages in their life cycle. They are:

- Inception
- Review
- Publication & Effect
- Maintenance & Decommissioning





Inception

Workforce System Policy Writing is a Collaborative Process

- Initial Planning
- Policy Memo
- Policy Owner Draft
- DART Initial Draft Review
- Policy Owner Revision
- DART Revision Review
- BWDA Policy & Planning Coordination Services Revision

Leadership Review

Workforce System Policy is Never Published without Leadership's Review and Consent

Leadership review of draft workforce system policies is three-tiered:

- Supervisors, chiefs, ARDs
- Bureau directors
- Executive leadership



Supporting Technology

Automated Workflows and Increased Accountability

- Workflow management tool
 - Custom built
 - Maintains version discipline
 - Asynchronous collaboration
- Improved accountability
- Comprehensive, real-time reporting





Publication & Effect

A Policy's Public Life

- Public comment
 - Usually 30 days
 - All received comments are carefully reviewed and fully considered
- Systematic review
 - Six-month review post-publication
 - Annual review for maintenance
- Decommissioning

Vigilance in Maintenance

- Persistent monitoring
- Six-month review post-publication
- Annual maintenance review
- Auto-generated reminders





Maintenance & Decommissioning

End of the Line

- Detailed in the Workforce System Policy Procedure Guide
- More than just removing from a web page
- Archived for historical and reference purposes
- Communication is key
