Funds allotted under Title I for Dislocated workers are used to establish a worker readjustment program that provides employment and training assistance for dislocated workers. A Dislocated Worker is defined as an individual who has been laid off, or who has received a notice of termination or layoff from employment due to plant closure or any substantial layoff, is eligible for or has exhausted entitlement to unemployment compensation (UC); or has been employed for a duration sufficient to demonstrate attachment to the labor force, but is not eligible for UC due to insufficient earnings or having performed services for an employer not covered under UC, and is unlikely to return to a previous industry or occupation. Authorized activities include, but are not limited to rapid response activities, outreach assistance, job search and placement assistance, counseling, training services, need related payments and other services authorized under the Act. Local areas are permitted to transfer up to a maximum of 30% of their funds between adult and dislocated worker activities .

Funds allotted under Title I for adults must be passed directly to local areas by formula mandated within the legislation. Through the America's Job Center, (PA CareerLink®) delivery system, adults access a continuum of services. Services are organized into three levels (core, intensive and training). Core services include, but are not limited to, outreach, assessment, job search, job placement, counseling and the provision of performance and cost information on eligible service providers of training services and information relating to the availability of supportive services. Intensive services include, but are not limited to, comprehensive and specialized assessment of skill levels, development of individual employment plans, counseling, case management and short term prevocational skills such as communication skills, interviewing skills and professional conduct. Training services include, but are not limited to, occupational skills training, on-the-job training, programs that combine workplace training with related instruction, skills upgrading and retraining, entrepreneurial training, job readiness training, adult education and literacy activities provided in combination with other training services and customized training. In general, individuals served are 18 years of age or older. In order to qualify for training programs, applicants must have met the requirements for intensive services, have received at least one intensive service and have been determined to be unable to obtain or retain employment. Youth between the ages of 18 and 21 may be classified as youth depending on the services provided. The purposes of these funds is to allow the establishment of a wide variety of employment and training activities. Local areas are permitted to transfer up to a maximum of 30% of funds between adult and dislocated worker activities.

Funds allocated under Title I for youth are used to provide employment and training activities for economically disadvantaged youth between the ages of 14 and 21. Youth between the ages of 18 and 21 may be classified as adults or youth depending on the services provided. The purpose of these activities is to provide eligible youth seeking assistance in achieving academic and employment assistance, success and options for improving educational and skill competencies. Allowable activities include, but are not limited to, tutoring, study skills training, instruction leading to completion of secondary school, dropout prevention, alternative secondary school programs, summer employment opportunities directly linked to academic and occupational learning, paid and unpaid work experience including internships, leadership development opportunities including community service, supportive services and occupations skill training. Thirty (30) percent of the funds shall be used to provide youth activities to out-of-school youth. These funds may also be used to support other youth initiatives as established in the President's Budget. A maximum of five percent of participants served in each local area may be individuals who do not meet the minimum income criteria, if the individuals are school dropouts, basic skill deficient, pregnant and parenting youth, youth with disabilities including learning disabilities, homeless or runaway, offenders, have educational attainment that is one or more grade levels below the grade level appropriate to the age of the individuals, or face other serious barriers to employment as identified by each local board.

Since 2000, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has provided a significant amount of annual funding support from the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) block grant to Local Workforce Development Boards (LWDBs), and their youth committees. The TANF Youth Development Program provides comprehensive services to youth by connecting them to available resources within their community. The program encourages the network of state and local youth services providers and workforce development providers along with public housing agencies to develop workforce programs for needy and at-risk youth that provide employment, educational experiences, and essential skills such as financial literacy and time management. TANF funds enhance WIOA Youth Formula funding and extend the availability of high-quality workforce investment activities to low-income youth, and to continue addressing the unique challenges that most often affect the ability of our young people to succeed.

PennServe acts as the administrative entity for federal grants authorized by the National Community Service Act with a variety of purposes and activities. The majority of the grants are sub-granted to locally based community service programs and are focused on service initiatives in education, environment, public safety and unmet human needs.

Wagner-Peyser is a staffing grant that is designed to provide quality employment and training services to assist individuals in finding employment and quality for meaningful employment and to help employers find the skilled workers they need.

Disabled Veterans' Outreach Program (DVOP) is a staffing grant that provides intensive services to meet the employment needs of disabled veterans and other eligible v. Emphasis is directed towards serving those who are economically or educationally disadvantaged, including homeless veterans and veterans with barriers to employment.

Local Veterans' Employment Representative (LVER) is a staffing grant that works with service providers to promote and facilitate priority of services to veterans. Staff act on behalf of veterans for employment and training opportunities with business, industry and community based organizations.

Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) is a Federal tax credit available to employers for hiring individuals from certain target groups who have faced significant barriers to WOTC staff work with other workforce programs that incentivize workplace diversity and facilitate access to good jobs.

Foreign Labor Certification (FLC) programs are designed to assure the admission of foreign workers to work in the US on a permanent or temporary basis will not adversely affect job opportunities, wages and working conditions of American workers.

The Trade Act of 1974, as amended, is a federal program which provides multiple benefits to eligible participants whose employment was affected by foreign imports. The include training, income support while in training, job search and relocation for work outside of their commuting area, and a wage subsidy program for older workers.

The Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) is the USDOL entity responsible for conducting research related to labor economics and for collecting and analyzing employment and occupational statistics. Through Cooperative Agreements with each state's Labor Market Information (LMI) shop, BLS provides funding to collect, edit, and analyze employment, occupational (OES), and workforce safety (SOII) information.
