

# Summer Academy Resident Staff Employment Opportunity!

## Summer Academy for Students who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing

Located at Penn State University – University Park Campus State College, Pennsylvania, the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation’s Deaf and Hard of Hearing Summer Academy Program is designed to offer high school age students who are deaf, hard of hearing or DeafBlind an opportunity to develop their knowledge, experiences and awareness as it relates to their future academic and employment goals. Students will participate in a 10-day-long program on a college campus, where they will receive assessments, information and educational experiences in various curriculum areas related to communication access, college skills, vocational skills, and social and emotional skills. Resident Assistants (RAs) and Resident Directors (RDs) will be hired to provide direct support to students and staff during the program. Applicants need to be able to commit to staying on campus and in the dorm, as well as working the full length of the program.

### The following positions are available:

- **22 Resident Assistants:** These positions pay a daily rate of \$150 and would be assigned to morning or evening shifts.
- **2 Resident Directors:** These positions pay a daily rate of \$200 and would be assigned to morning or evening shifts.

**\*Housing, meals and parking are provided.**

**\*All employees will receive a paycheck via direct deposit approximately 60 days from the end of the program.**
