




Q5: In what year of provisional registration are you currently?




Q6: What are you doing to improve your interpreting skills?








Q25: Should the requirements to register with ODHH be the same for deaf interpreters and hearing interpreters?





Q27: Is 3 years enough time for a provisionally registered interpreter to become state-registered?





Q28: How many years should a provisionally registered interpreter be permitted to work before being required to be state-registered?





Q29: Should provisionally registered interpreters be required to participate in mentoring?






