## Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP)

**Mission** - The Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) is a community service and work-based job training program for older Americans. Authorized by the Older Americans Act, and funded by the U.S. Department of Labor, the program provides training for lowincome, unemployed seniors. Participants also have access to employment assistance through American Job Centers.

SCSEP participants gain work experience in a variety of community service activities at nonprofit and public facilities, including schools, hospitals, day-care centers, and senior centers. The program provides over 40 million community service hours to public and non-profit agencies, allowing them to enhance and provide needed services. Participants work an average of 20 hours a week, and are paid the highest of federal, state or local minimum wage. This training serves as a bridge to unsubsidized employment opportunities for participants. Participants can remain in the program for 48 months in a lifetime.

**Participant Eligibility** – The program is for Pennsylvania residents, ages 55 or older, who are unemployed, and have income at or below 125% of the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines.
