

The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) is one of Pennsylvania's largest employers, with approximately 22,000 military and civilian personnel in some 91 communities statewide.

The DMVA provides advice and assistance to Pennsylvania's more than 894,000 Veterans and their families and to provide quality care to aging Veterans. There is a wide range of federal, state and county benefits available to qualified Veterans and their families. The DMVA, County Directors of Veterans Affairs and Veteran Service Organizations assist Veterans in applying for these benefits. Pennsylvania offers its Veterans six extended care facilities throughout the state. The level of care provided includes personal care, skilled nursing care, domiciliary care, and dementia care. These facilities offer qualified Veterans and their spouses dedicated, superior care.

The Pennsylvania National Guard (PNG) prepares for combat, performing worldwide combat and combat support operations, providing global reach and the projection of U.S. military power in support of national objectives; and, at the command of the governor, providing trained personnel to support state and local authorities in times of natural disaster or civil strife. It is important to note that DMVA also serves as an advocate for Pennsylvania's larger military community to include installations, personnel and resources from all branches of service located in the commonwealth. The DMVA and PNG are headquartered at Fort Indiantown Gap in Lebanon County.
